Cost:	£18 which covers transport, insurance and the entrance fee to Creswell Crags.
Clothing:	School Uniform jumper with dark-coloured suitable trouser bottoms - we will be outside so suitable jacket/coat and shoes for the weather.
Time to arrive at school:	8:40 am prompt. Coach to leave school at 9:00am.
Lunch:	Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (preferably with a sports cap to prevent leakages) and NO GLASS BOTTLES OR FIZZY DRINKS PLEASE.
Collection time:	3:30pm approx.
Medicine	If your child needs to take medication, please complete an authorisation form, available from the school office, and see your child's class teacher. This includes any Travel sickness medication, which needs to be administered by a member of staff for the return journey.
Arbor & Parental Consent	For your child to go on this trip we need you to agree consent via the Arbor app. We cannot accept verbal consent. If we do not receive consent, we will be unable to take your child out of school. Please complete and make a payment via Arbor by 10 th April. Thank you
