Date of Visit	Thursday 27 th April 2023
Cost:	£14.00 which covers transport, insurance and the entrance fee to Creswell Craggs.
Clothing:	School Uniform – trouser bottoms; we will be outside so suitable clothing for the weather.
Time to arrive at school:	8:40 am prompt. Coach to leave school at 9:00am.
Lunch:	Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (preferably with a sports cap to prevent leakages) and NO GLASS BOTTLES OR FIZZY DRINKS PLEASE.
Collection time:	3:30pm approx.
Spending money	£2.00 for a pre-made gift bag to be collected by your child's teacher a day or two before the trip.
Medicine	If your child needs to take medication please complete an authorisation form, available from the school office, and see your child's class teacher. This includes any Travel sickness medication, which needs to be administered by a member of staff for the return journey.
ParentPay & Parental Consent	For your child to go on this trip we need you to agree consent via the ParentPay system. We cannot accept verbal consent. If we do not receive consent, we will be unable to take your child out of school. Please complete and make a payment via the ParentPay system by Friday 21 st April. Thank you
