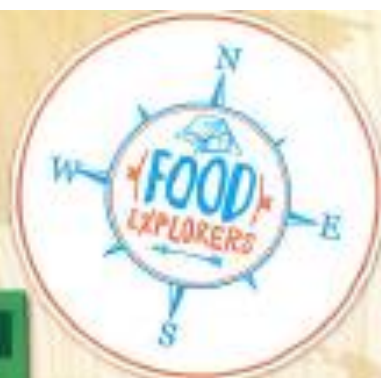
West End Workshops
