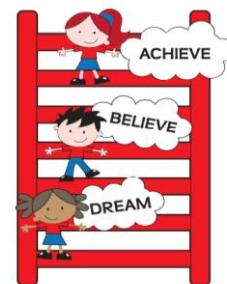

Dear Families,

As I write this letter I can't quite believe we are at the end of week three. We have fitted a lot into the new term. Already some children have been on school trips, experienced being an Egyptian for the day and made new friends along the way.

It is wonderful that children are continuing to use Seesaw to showcase their work and for families to see this too. Can I ask that you continue to use Seesaw to contact staff but please be mindful that staff **might** only reply during the hours of **8:30am and 4:30pm (Mon- Fri)**. If you need an immediate reply, then the school office might be a more suitable way to make contact.

Also, some families have asked about Remote Learning when their child/ren are isolating. Staff will contact families once a confirmed PCR test result is obtained to discuss remote learning needs. If families, feel anxious about sending child/ren to school if they live with someone who has received a positive result then I ask you to contact school directly and we can support you.

Can I also politely ask that younger children stay close to their parents and carers when collecting/ dropping off siblings. School does not finish until 3:20pm so lessons will still be taking place. I am also worried that we might have some accidents when younger children are playing and running around at the front of school.

Finally, can all school clothing be named. We are already filling our lost property box!! I have personally sorted through this and returned items with names written inside. At this point, I would like to say thank you to families who have sent their children in smart uniforms each day including PE days. It is important that on PE days that children wear correct kits including plain white t-shirts and black/ blue bottoms.
